Investment & Evolution: Primary Care Networks (PCNs)

Purpose:

To brief the committee on the outcome of the practice submissions to form PCNs.

Background:

In January 2019, as part of the NHS Long Term Plan, a general practice specific document, 'Investment & Evolution' was published detailing significant change to general practice.

A new Network Contract Directed Enhanced Service (Directed Enhanced Service) has been created which requires practices to form PCNs. The deadline for submission of proposals to the CCG for the composition of the PCNs was 15 May, and all practices met this deadline.

Analysis of key issues and of risks

Under delegation from the Committee, the Chief Officer reviewed the submissions and all PCNs have been approved; all patients in every GP practice are covered by a PCN and there is 100 per cent geographical coverage in Rotherham (see appendices for details).

The ICS has confirmed support to the PCNs in Rotherham but not currently for all

practices in South Yorkshire and Bassetlaw.

These are the next steps for PCNs:

- Each practice will sign-up to the Network Contract DES through the Calculating Quality Reporting Service (CQRS), when available, and by confirming the agreement in writing with the CCG.
- Practices must ensure the full Network Agreement is completed and signed prior to 30 June 2019 (note the deadline for this paper is 26 June hence correct at the time of writing).
- Practices must also ensure they have in place appropriate data sharing arrangements and, if required, data processor arrangements that are compliant with data protection legislation to support the delivery of extended hours access services prior to 30 June 2019.
- The Primary Care Team will create a template to ensure these confirmations are completed consistently. A PCN will be considered to be established once this confirmation is received.
- All practices that have signed up to the Network Contract DES and provided confirmation of the above will be eligible to claim the Network Participation Payment from 1 July 2019 to support engagement (£1.761 per weighted patient per year), and backdated to 1 April 2019.

The CCG will continue to support the emerging PCNs in this process.

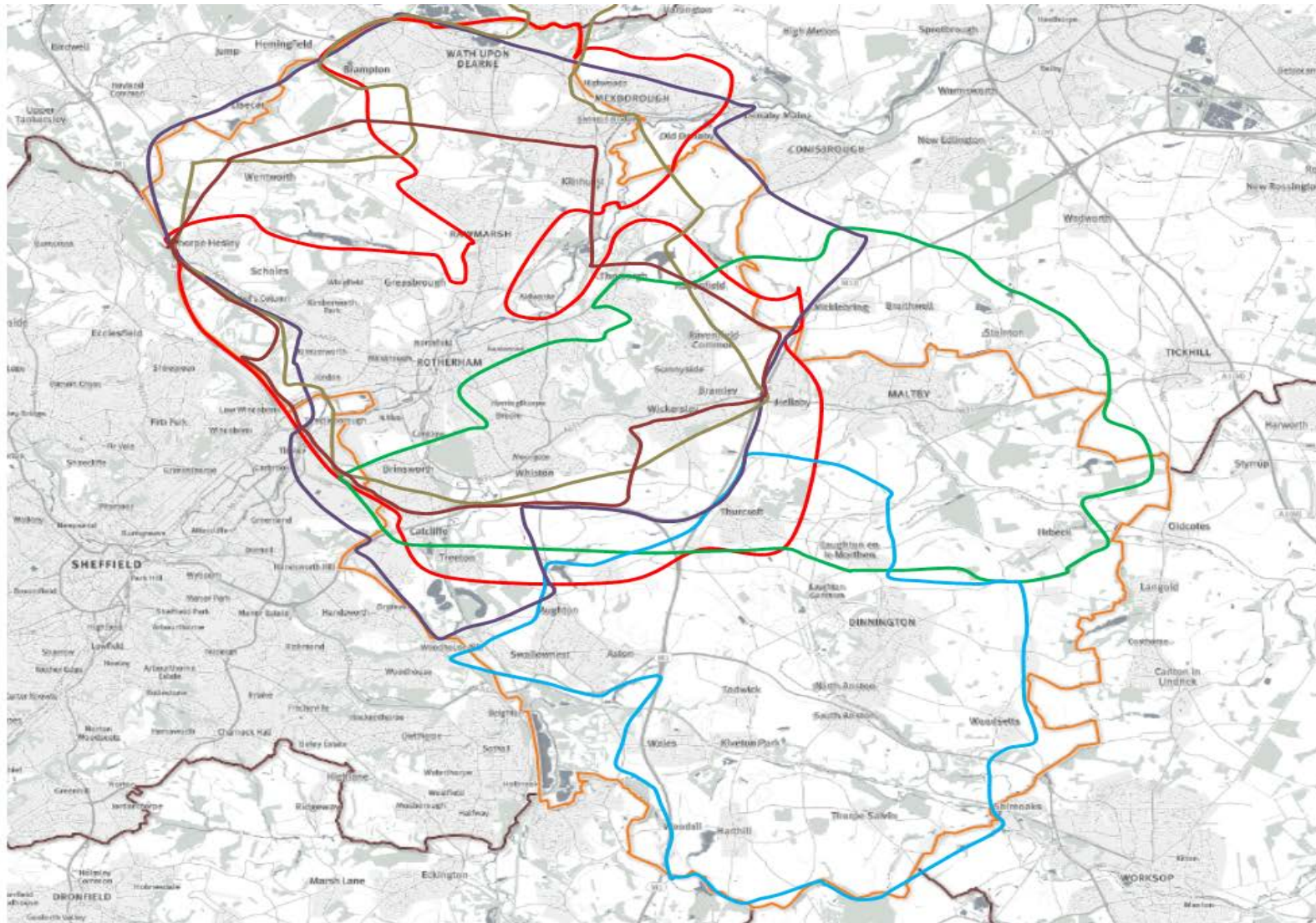
